#### Be sure to read this important information before you register

Registration for Weekend in the “Son” Women’s Retreat will open on **Sunday May 3rd at 5pm**. Weekend in the “Son” will be held at Grove Hall Retreat Center in OG, NJ. The retreat center consists of 31 double occupancy rooms with 2 different price points \$160 and \$185 depending on room type. All tickets includes 5 meals and two beach passes. **Each ticket reserves a bed in a shared room, not a room to ones self.**

Tickets for a **shared room** with **community bathroom** are priced at **\$160**. There are community bathrooms located on each floor

Tickets for a shared room with a private in room bathroom goes for **\$185**. **There are a very limited number of the shared rooms with a private bathroom and it will be distributed on a first come first serve basis.** Keep in mind that these rooms fill up within the first minutes of registration. Once they are sold out that ticket will be closed.

When filling out the registration form, there will be a slot to add a roommate request. In order for us to accommodate friend requests properly, each person must have the same ticket type. **For instance, if you and a friend are requesting to room with each other but one purchased a ticket with a private bathroom at \$185, and the other purchased a standard room at \$160, this request to room together would be denied due to the difference in price.** For this reason, when registering, it would be beneficial to list three different friends you prefer to room with, this way we can accommodate your request better.

**Please keep in mind when trying to reserve a shared room with a private bath that these rooms are extremely limited (about 9 spots total) and usually sell out within the first minute. That being said, if you are not ok with sharing a room with someone that you don't know, then the private bath option is not a good option for you since past history has proven that the likelihood of a person and their friend managing to get the same private bath ticket before it sells out is very slim to none. Since these room types are purchased on a first come first serve basis, we can only place you with those who purchased the same ticket type. We can not make any exceptions to accommodate roommate requests if the ticket types are not the same since the rooms with a private bath are charged at a higher premium.**

This standard applies for handicap rooms as well. Grove Hall has 3 handicap rooms located on the first floor priced at **\$160**. These are standard shared rooms with a community bathroom and they are located on the first floor. That makes 6 total handicap spots available. **Since these rooms are limited, we must reserve them for women who have difficulty physically walking up the stairs due to health concerns. As far as roommate requests go, if you would like to stay with a friend who needs a handicap room, but you do not have a handicap yourself, unfortunately we cannot accommodate this request to room together.** We can only make this accommodation if the handicap rooms don't fill with those in need of this particular type of room.

We are excited to see what God has in store for us as we experience a balance of light-hearted fellowship at the beach, sincere worship, and biblical teaching to help us grow in the knowledge and love of Christ.
